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General information

Class Policy and Procedure

The students and the faculty of Power Leadership Institute, adhere to every law regarding ethical use of other people's material, whether it is printed, video, audio, multimedia, or computer programs of any kind. It is expected that every student be honest and not copy in exams and reports. Each student should work independently in his reports and exams. He who copies shows lack of integrity that is not accepted in the secular much less in a Christian institute. Therefore, if a student is found copying, he will receive an "F" in the class.

This class will be governed according to the information of **Schedule Students**. Also we reserve the right to change or to modify the classes and dates, according to the needs of the teacher, the establishment, or the class. All students are responsible to be aware of such changes, which will be announced ahead of time.

Students are responsible to obtain the material of the classes missed and to stay up to date. During this course you will take short exams, according to the academic calendar. The fact that you did not study for said exam, will not be a valid reason not to take it on the day scheduled.

Important information on Book Reports and Class Projects

For very important things, you should consider while writing your reports and projects:

1. **Each report must contain the following:**

- **Name of student**
- **Date**
- **Name of course**
- **Description of report:** Every report (class and book report) must start with the description of the report as stated in the syllabus. This text is clearly indicated (highlighted in color and bold within borders) in each subject and each report in this syllabus. **Please copy this text as the start of every report.**

2. Reports need to be named clearly using the following format – yyyy-mm-dd/initials of student/initials of course (for example 2019-09-14 EV IH). All reports need to be in Word or Pdf format. Completed reports need to be emailed to admin@pli.am.

3. **Presentation:** Remember that everything what we do must be done as if it were for the Lord. The Work must be neat, presentable. **All material by computer must be in Times New Roman font, and font size must be 12pt, with margins kept no less than 1,5 cm.**

4. **Content:** This implies that it must be specific to what is requested. The work turned in must be your own and not done in a group effort.

Book reports should focus on how the book impacted and changed your way of thinking – how are you implementing now what you learned from the book and what are the effects thereof. This should **not** be a report that only summarizes the book.

5. **Creativity:** God created you as an original, so do not conform to being a copy, be yourself. Ask the Holy Spirit to aid you and see what amazing ideas He will give you to complete your projects and reports. It is not acceptable to copy material obtained in the internet and make it seem like it is your own work. You may gather and collect small portions that will enrich your report but be sure to use quotations and give credit to the original writer in the bibliography section of your report.

6. **Bibliography:** All material that is not your own (Ex. Illustrations, photos, quoted material) should be identified in its text appropriately. Furthermore, a bibliography page should be added in the back of your report and such things should be included there.

Important information on exams

All mentioned dates for exams and reports are fixed. Only in extreme circumstances will allowances be made to deviate from them. This will be done on a case-by-case basis. Students that want to apply for this allowance need to send their request to admin@pli.am. The request must contain clear reasons why the student is applying for an extension to the date and must be sent at least 1 week before the due date. Note that if an extension for an exam is granted, the student will need to sit the exam within a 2-week period after the originally assigned date. This will take place in the office during office hours (Monday, Tuesday or Thursday from 9:00 until 15:00). Online students will receive their exam instructions by mail and complete the exam online on the assigned day.

Inner Healing & Deliverance I (PRCA 101)

(Initials of course: IH1)

Course Objective

The objectives of the class will be for the student to understand the following concepts:

- To take the student to the understanding of why there are things happening within them and how they can be free from them.
- How to be free from rejection?
- Steps to forgiveness. Why we can't forgive ourselves sometimes?
- How the root of bitterness tears us apart?
- The four spiritual laws.

Course Description

In this course we will discuss the importance of discovering and understanding the different symptoms and stages that a person goes through when they have been hurt and have had to deal with difficult circumstances through life. In doing this, they are able to confess sins and openly speak of situations of their past so that they are able to renounce those curses in their lives and be set free.

The following requirements should be completed satisfactory in order to pass this course.

(The book report on chapters 8 through 17 will follow in the second trimester.) This report must be done on a computer or typewriter and it should contain 3 complete pages. Book reports may be written in English or Dutch. **Do not forget to write your name on the report. This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Class Project or Laboratory

Please copy the following text as start to your report:

Write a report on what you have learned about inner healing and deliverance that you did not know before. How has this class helped you in your own inner healing process?

This additional report must be done on a computer or typewriter and it should contain 2 complete pages. The report can be written in English or Dutch. **This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Final Exam

Prayer (DECR 101)

(Initials of course: Prayer)

Course Description

In this course the student will discover the secret to pray and fast effectively making this a lifestyle.

- By the end of the trimester, the student will be able to recognize and overcome the obstacles that keep him/her from praying.
- The student will learn and practice different ways to pray. This will enrich their devotional time with God.

This report must be done on a computer or typewriter and it should contain 3 complete pages. Book reports may be written in English or Dutch. **Do not forget to write your name on the report. This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Class Project or Laboratory

Please copy the following text as start to your report:

This class project consists of coming together in agreement with one person to pray for one specific petition or need you both have. This person needs to be a Christian experienced in prayer warfare who can stand in agreement with you. Joining up with someone also following this course is a good idea. It is not required to be physically together each time you pray. You will pray for that petition for four weeks, 15 minutes daily, with the purpose of seeing a breakthrough or changes in that situation. After the four weeks are up, you will evaluate how the results of your prayers came about. You will report this experience in a report and you should include what was the situation for which you were praying for. If both parties are following this course, both will need to write their own reports, documenting their personal experience. You may create a fictitious name for the other person (the real name should be kept confidential).

This report must be done on a computer or typewriter and it should contain 2 complete pages. The report can be written in English or Dutch. **Do not forget to write your name on the report. This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Final Exam

The Vision (DECR 110)

(Initials of course: Vision)

Course Description

As we understand that *vision* is the revelation of the plan and purpose of God for our lives, this course is intended to guide students to learn how to identify themselves with our vision (Evangelize, Affirm, Disciple and Send). We will explain the importance and influence of the spiritual retreats in the life of the believer.

Course Objective

Some of the goals for this class will be:

- Ensure that students become part of the vision of the church.
- Assimilate in depth each of the elements that form part of the vision.
- Practice each of the procedures for carrying out the vision.
- Generate a comprehensive growth in each of the members of the church.

The final exam is composed of 50 questions. It covers everything that was taught during the sessions in the class. It will include True and False questions as well as Multiple Choice questions. **This exam is worth 40% of the class.**

Inner Healing & Deliverance II (PRCA 102)

(Initials of course: IH2)

Course Objectives:

- Learn the meaning of deliverance that is the children's bread.
- Know the origin of demons
- Know and identify the areas in which deliverance is needed.
- Learn to identify and break curses.
- Learn to minister deliverance.

Course Description

This course is a thorough study of the existence of deliverance in the Church of Christ; known as part of the gift God gave us as children. Be free and free others in the name of Jesus to fulfill God's purpose effectively. Casting out demons and deliverance is a mystery that can only be understood through the revelation of the Holy Spirit.

Course Requirements

The following requirements should be completed satisfactory in order to pass this course.

Once you have been delivered, you will proceed to minister the inner healing process to a family member, a friend or co-worker, with their consent. This is to put in practice what you have learned and what has been imparted to you. You should follow-up on the person you minister and show them the love of Christ.

This additional report must be done in a computer or typewriter and it should contain 2 complete pages. The report can be written in English or Dutch. **This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Principles of the Doctrine of Christ – TEOR 101

(Initials of course: PDC)

Course Description

A study of the six points we find in Hebrews 6:12 regarding the doctrine of Christ, repentance from dead works, faith in God, the doctrine of baptisms, the laying of hands, the resurrection of the dead and final judgment.

Course Objective

This teaching is designed to train students who want to be used by God, and that they may have a firm foundation. When this course is finished, the student can feel secure in their belief in God and everything to do with the knowledge of the doctrine of Christ.

This additional project must be typed and contain 2 full pages. This project is required to evaluate the student in the practical area. The report can be written in English or Dutch. **Do not forget to write your name on the report. This report is worth 20% of your grade.**

Final Exam

The final exam is composed of 50 questions. It covers everything that was taught during the sessions in the class. It will include True and False questions as well as Multiple Choice questions. **This exam is worth 35% of the class.**

Character of a Leader – (DECR120)

(Initials of course: CL)

Course Description

This course is designed to enable students to develop their character. We will study with the scale as a symbol or figure of what is the character and charisma of a person, since it is necessary that both be on the same level in order to reach the destiny God has for our lives.

Supernatural Evangelism (EPRCA 110)

(Initials of course: SE)

Course Description

Teach and train each child of God to fulfill the high calling that Jesus Christ has delegated in His word, when He commissioned *“He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.”(Mark 16:15)*

Course Objective

The objective and main goal is that by completing this course, the Holy Spirit has done the work in each student by planting in their hearts and unleashing a passion and burden for the lost so that when they go on the streets with that same passion and so in that manner fulfill the sacred mission of evangelizing to a world searching desperately for a word that can change their lives. Outside there are over six million people who have not yet heard of Jesus. Someone is waiting for each one of us to present them to Jesus Christ, who will save their lives. The Apostle Paul said: *“How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?”* (Romans 10: 14)

Spiritual Maturity– (EDECR220)

(Initials of course: SM)

Course Description

This course will be a deep study about the levels of spiritual growth that every believer must go through, in order to grow every day and to be able to help others to mature. As well as understanding the importance of service to please God and reach new spiritual levels.

Course Objective

Some of the objectives of the class will be:

- To obtain the mentality of Jesus Christ in relation to service and to learn how to receive the anointing mantle through serving.
- To have clarity as to what the gift of service consists of.
- To know and understand the different levels of spiritual maturity. .
- How to grow or mature spiritually.
- Recognize the importance of maturing for each believer.

The following requirements should be completed satisfactory in order to pass this course.

Midterm Exam

The midterm exam is composed of 50 questions. It will include True and False questions as well as Multiple Choice questions. **This exam is worth 30% of the class.**

Class Project or Laboratory

Please copy the following text as start to your report:

Serve (other areas than your normal area of service) in a place where you fill the need of a person, church, work etc. For example, clean bathrooms, baby sit etc. Give a short report (less than half page) of your experience.

The report can be written in English or Dutch. **Do not forget to write your name on the report. This report is worth 30% of your grade.**
